COURSE FEE CREDIT FOR PRIOR WINE STUDY

Students who have already completed certain Wine qualifications may receive a credit on their course fees, provided the following conditions are met:

- The qualification is one of the following:
 - Certificate in New Zealand Wine Micro-Credential;
 - Certificate in New Zealand Wine Advanced Micro-Credential;
 - WSET Level 2 Award in Wines;
 - WSET Level 2 Award in Spirits; or
 - WSET Level 3 Award in Wines.
- The credit is available for courses completed at NZSFW or with other providers. The value of courses completed at other providers will be set at the NZSFW Part Time course fee for the equivalent course, which can be found on our short course pages.
- The maximum credit available is NZ\$2,500.

Where a credit is recognised for a specific qualification, the student will not attend the scheduled classes pertaining to that qualification for a second time.
